Advisory Committees to the Board

In an ongoing effort to increase communication with the public and to provide for citizen involvement, the Board may appoint advisory committees. The Board will determine the composition, number of members, manner of appointment and duties. Board reserves the right to end the committee at any time.

Additionally, upon petition of at least two component school districts, the Board shall establish a local advisory committee(s) to represent the interest of a specified area within the ESD region. The local committee(s) shall advise the Board on matters of area-wide concern.

All meetings of advisory committees shall be considered open meetings and comply with the Public Meetings Law. Recommendations of such committees will be given careful consideration by the Board. The Board's responsibility, however, cannot be delegated or surrendered to others; therefore, all recommendations of an advisory committee must be submitted to the Board for action and must be recognized as advisory in nature.
