## First Aid - Emergency Medical Plan

1. To ensure the ready availability of emergency medical services to students, employees or others using ESD facilities who experience **MAJOR ILLNESSES OR INJURIES**, the ESD will utilize existing outside emergency medical services for the Albany area. There will be an annual review of all emergency medical plans, including plans for those ESD programs outside of the Albany urban area.

No employee of ESD shall comply with any directive from parents or others, whether written or verbal, that life-sustaining emergency care be withheld from a student in need of such care while under the control of ESD staff. Examples of life-sustaining emergency care may include: efforts to stop bleeding, unblocking airways, mouth-to-mouth resuscitation, and cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR).

## DIAL 911 for emergency medical services

The response system will be provided by the City of Albany ambulance service with a response time of approximately three minutes.

Dial 911 in all life threatening situations or when the injury or illness is severe. Examples of severe injuries/illnesses include:

- a. Severe bleeding;
- b. Breathing difficulties;
- c. Seizures;
- d. Unconsciousness;
- e. Injuries caused by a fall;
- f. Chest pains;
- g. Suspected or apparent broken bones.

Emergency medical services will respond and can decide if emergency transport is necessary.

Procedure to be followed when a serious medical situation arises:

- a. Do not move the victim.
- b. Make sure someone stays with the victim when going for help;
- c. Dial 911, and be prepared to provide the following information to the dispatcher:
  - 1. Your name;
  - 2. The building location with street address;
  - 3. The nature of the problem;

- 4. The status of the victim;
- 5. The location of the victim.
- d. Provide someone to direct the emergency medical services personnel when they
- 2. To treat all reasonably expected injuries or illnesses, the Education Service District will:
  - a. Provide first-aid training for a representative number of employees interested in obtaining and retaining first-aid certification;
  - b. Provide first-aid supplies in both ESD buildings and vehicles of the type and quantity needed, based on potential hazards and injury/illness history.
