- Participants will receive a stipend per session
- **Year 1** Sessions alternate between a community of practice where participants learn about new tools and resources, while also engaging with other mentors around their problems of practice and *Educators Thriving* sessions, which provide participants with the research, strategies, and resources to proactively support the social and emotional well-being of new teachers, with the goal of moving them from barely surviving to thriving.
- **Year 2** participants will engage in 5 new sessions of Educators Thriving
